Good Evening Faiss Families,

For one last time this school year, here are some reminders for what's happening at Faiss.

As today was the last day of school for students, Faiss teachers and staff will not be formally checking on students or providing assignments any longer. However, please know your son/daughter are definitely not far from our thoughts as we are planning for the start of the new school year, which will hopefully happen in August. As that information becomes more clear, I will communicate with you all.

# Faiss Middle School End of Year Information May 2020

The following is information Faiss families need to know concerning the closing of this school year. Many of these dates are undetermined at this time as we must wait until our Governor initiates Phase II of the reopening plan for Nevada.

### Student Item Pickup (Date undetermined at this time):

During Phase I, our teachers were able to return in very small groups to wrap up the school year from May 18-May 21st. Their first task was to gather all student items and bag/label these for student distribution. However, please note that the student items may or may not be returned this summer, depending on State and CCSD guidelines. Here are points to understand for this process:

We will have alphabetically assigned days and times for Item Deployment . This will be communicated to you as soon as we receive a date to begin the process. Please know that this is due to the numbers of students/items we have and due to the small number of staff allowed on campus; therefore, we will have to schedule pickups accordingly. We will ensure that all siblings items can be collected at the same time even if last names differ. If you are unable to make it during your assigned date and time, we will have alternative dates once most items have been dispersed. Everyone must remain in their car at all times in order to maintain social distancing guidelines and for everyone's safety. If you have questions during this process, please call 702-799-6850 ext 4000. We will have staff in the office answering the phones during Item Deployment.

This process will occur in our front parking lot. Traffic may be heavy at times, please remain calm and cautious. We will have staff directing traffic and signs to provide instructions throughout the parking lot to keep this process as smooth as possible.

Item Deployment will occur in stations and signs will be posted with instructions. Each station will have a purpose. For example, one station will be for picking up items and another for dropping off. This is necessary for sanitizing items we receive, please be sure to read and follow all posted signs.

More information, including a map and assigned dates/times for Item Deployment will follow as decisions are made by the State and CCSD pertaining to Phase II of reopening plans. Please note that during Phase I, campuses are closed.

#### **Item Drop-Off** (Date undetermined at this time):

Your student(s) may have items that they need to return to the school such as instruments, library books, sports uniforms, etc. For your convenience, Item Drop-Off will occur at the same time as Item Deployment. There will be different stations for Item Pick-Up & Item Drop off. We are not able to touch items dropped off for a number of days per health and safety guidelines. At the Item Drop-Off Station, staff members will bring boxes/bins close to your car for you to place the items in. Please be sure to label these items with the student's name and ID number. We are not able to label the items during Drop-Off so please ensure that this is done in advance. If you would like to return a chromebook that you checked out, you may do so at Item Drop-Off.

## PE Locker Items/Yearbooks /Sports Pictures (Date undetermined at this time):

PE Locker items, Yearbooks and Sports pictures will be placed in an envelope to be picked up during the student Item deployment. There may be end of year awards or other paper items in this envelope as well. **YEARBOOKS ARE STILL FOR SALE for \$35.** As long as the yearbook is purchased prior to the first day of Item Disbursement, it will be included in your student's pick-up bag. Please visit <a href="www.faissmiddleschool.net">www.faissmiddleschool.net</a> to purchase your yearbook. If the webstore is not working, you will be able to pay with cash during item pickup.

## **Summer School Information**

Middle school students who have failed a class are eligible or may be required to make up the class through summer

school in order to be promoted to the next grade. Registration for summer school must be initiated by your son/daughter's counselor. If you have a question, please contact them via email. Each student must be registered every year for school per Nevada State Law.
